ORDER CONCERNING CLOTHING AND RESTRAINTS IN COURT


The Court, having heard and considered *Defendant's motion to allow Accused to appear in her own clothing and without visible restraints at all court appearances*, sustains the motion in part and denies it in part, as follows:

1. That portion of the motion requesting that Ms. Bustamante be allowed to appear in her own clothing during all court appearances is sustained, subject to 19th Judicial Circuit Court Rule 9.4. It shall be the responsibility of defense counsel to provide the personal clothing to the Cole County Sheriff in sufficient time to allow compliance with this order.

2. That portion of the motion requesting that Ms. Bustamante be allowed to wear her own clothing during transport to court appearances is denied. Whether Ms. Bustamante changes into her personal clothing before or after transport is left to the discretion of the Sheriff.

3. That portion of the motion requesting the use of restraints is sustained in part. Visible restraints shall not be used upon Ms. Bustamante while in Court or while she is brought into the courtroom. Otherwise, the request concerning restraints is denied.
